He was genuinely kind, down to earth, selfless and generous, with the ability to make anyone he met—no matter how briefly—feel special. Carson was the essence of leadership without needing the glory, setting an example for others with just his uplifting spirit and smile. What mattered most to Carson was making others feel as happy about life as he was, and forever paying forward all the blessings he was so fortunate to experience.

Two \$2500.00 scholarships will be awarded to Orchard Park High School Seniors who intend to pursue higher education. These students should embody the spirit of Carson, demonstrating a commitment to making a real impact in their community through a love for life, compassion for others, and with a heart full of friendship and optimism.

Essay questions are required. A personal interview with the finalists may be requested. Scholarship winners will be asked to attend the annual Carson Senfield Impact Foundation golf tournament at Cloverbank Country Club on June 23, 2005.
